\*\* A supplementary report obtained subsequent to an Impairment or Independent examination/report is interpreted as a report sought for the purposes of requesting clarification of additional information not available at the time of the original examination. This does not include information omitted from the original report which reasonably could have been expected to be included.

\*\*\* A follow-up report obtained from a treating practitioner is interpreted as a report providing additional information in relation to the ongoing treatment of the patient. A follow-up report will only be requested subsequent to the provision of a standard report.

\*\*\*\*These fees apply to 4th edition impairment reports requested by the TAC and where the medical practitioner abides by the *Conditions Under Which Medical Examinations Are Carried Out On Behalf Of The TAC*. The bonus payment is payable only when the TAC receives the report within 14 days of the impairment assessment or in the case of a Legal Firm seeking reimbursement when TAC receives the report within 28 days of the impairment assessment.

The 'Bonus Fee' payable by the TAC for 4th Edition Impairment reports can be paid only when the TAC receives the report within 14 days of the assessment date. When a Legal Firm is seeking reimbursement for the cost of a 4th edition impairment report the TAC will consider paying the 'Bonus Fee' when the report is received within 28 days of the assessment date. When billing the Tax invoice must include both the standard report item number and associated fee, as well as the 'Bonus' item number and related fee.
